Lead: can damage the nervous system

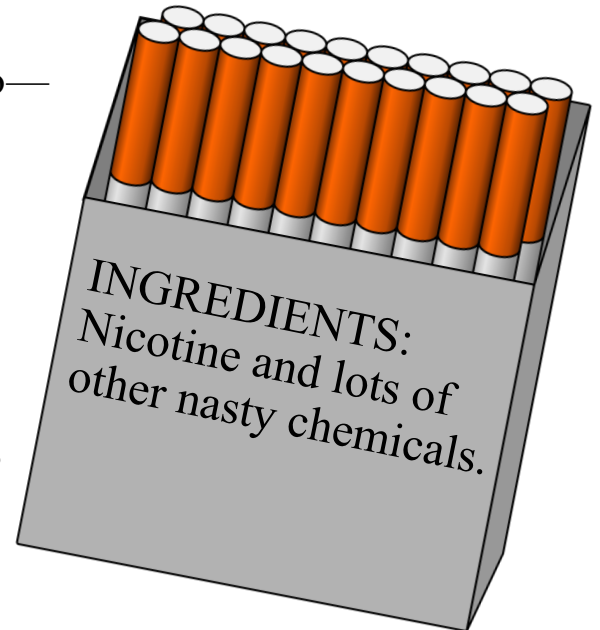
Formaldehyde: used to preserve dead specimens
